Each day offers multiple routes and activity levels, giving you the freedom to decide how much adventure you want.

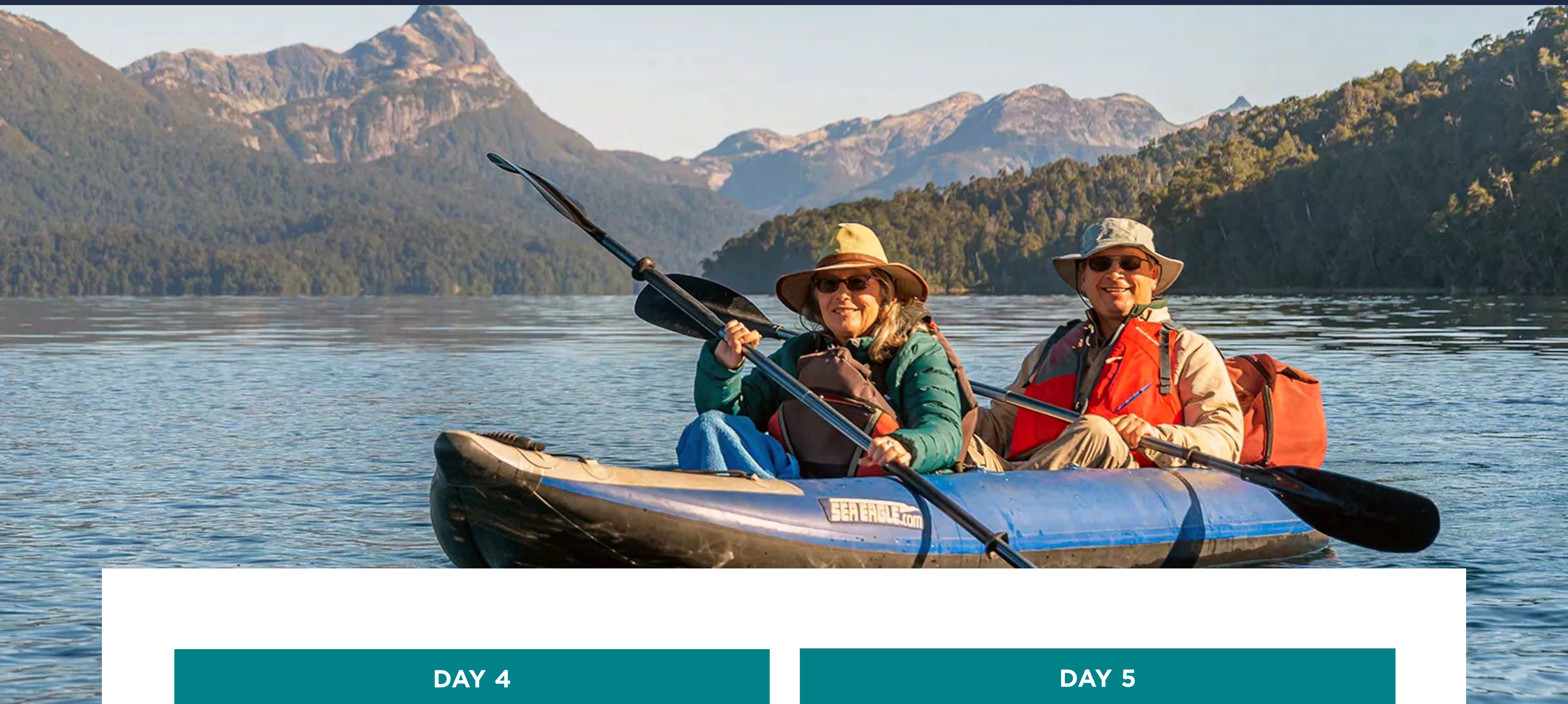

#### ROUTE AND TERRAIN NOTES

Hiking routes wind through forest and mountain landscapes, ranging from well-maintained dirt trails to rocky paths with uneven steps and tree roots. In dry conditions, trails can be quite dusty, especially on days that include horseback riding.

Biking routes on this trip travel through forests and alongside lakes and rivers, featuring rolling terrain with a few steeper sections. Rides follow a mix of paved and dirt roads, including some rough and sandy sections, which can make the routes feel more challenging than the mileage may suggest. You'll ride hybrid bikes suited for non-technical dirt roads (approximately 30%) and paved roads (approximately 70%). Riding conditions may vary with the weather, with terrain ranging from dusty, rugged to smooth.

#### ABOUT YOUR BIKE

Some routes on this trip include rough or uneven surfaces. To ensure a comfortable and confident ride, we provide high-quality bikes specifically selected for the terrain. While these aren't our standard Backroads bikes, they offer the stability, control and comfort this region calls for.
